

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

Between

FACULTY OF HEALTH SCIENCES OF ESA UNGGUL UNIVERSITY

and

COLLEGE OF MEDICAL AND HEALTH SCIENCES OF ASIA UNIVERSITY

The MoA is signed based on the MoU between Esa Unggul University (EUU) and Asia University (AU). Considering that joint activities can be conducted either by EUU or AU, then in this MoA as the host university hereinafter called the "Host" and attending university hereinafter known as the "Guest". This agreement aims to promote international collaboration to advance medical and health sciences education and to provide the basis for a collegial relationship between the institutions.

The scope of cooperation consists of various activities as described below.

1. Faculty member and/or visiting faculty programs exchanges

- 1.1. This activity can be conducted by sharing in academics activities through Public Lecture. It can be carried out either at EUU or AU. Lecturers of AU may deliver Public Lecture at EUU for a certain period of time (up to one week), and Vice Versa.
- 1.2. During the activities, Host may provide temporary accommodation while other expenses as air ticket and living cost should be provided by Guest University lecturers.

2. Undergraduate and Postgraduate student exchanges for professional and cultural enrichment

- 2.1. Activities can be done by sending students from AU to EUU to learn Indonesian culture and language, and vice versa.
- 2.2. This activity is expected to start in 2017, where 50 students of AU will participate in this program. This program will be conducted for a certain period of time (maximum 3 months), while some students of EUU will be sent to AU to learn Taiwan culture and language.
- 2.3. Host will provide accommodation, while other expenses such as flight ticket and living cost during activities will be provided by the Guest.

3. Joint degree (2 + 2) program for bachelor

- 3.1. Activities can be conducted by implementing Bachelor Degree (Undergraduate) program in nursing and nutrition.

- 3.2. The agreement focuses on the agreed 2 + 2 program in which the first two years of study (semester 1-4) is to be conducted at EUU and the second two years of study (semesters 5-8) is to be completed at AU. Therefore, the management of the faculty and study program both of EUU and AU have to sit together to discuss the suitability of courses and curriculum.
- 3.3. EUU will be responsible for teaching in the first two years of the program while AU will be responsible for the second two years teaching.
- 3.4. After completing all the credits required for AU's program as communicated by AU and EUU (and subject to payment of all relevant fees), the student shall obtain AU conferred Bachelor Degree which is recognized by the Taiwan Government and EUU conferred Bachelor Degree which is recognized by the Indonesian Government.

4. Joint degree (2 + 2) program for bachelor Fast track into Master (2 + 2) + (1)

- 4.1. The activity of Joint degree (2 + 2) programs may be developed into the accelerated program hereafter known as Fast Track program.
- 4.2. It is a continuation of the 2 + 2 program where students participating in the 2 + 2 program can be accelerated so that by the time the student enters the fourth year of the 2 + 2 program, students may register for the master's program.
- 4.3. The implementation of the 2 + 2 + 1 fast track program students may complete the Bachelor and Master Degree within five years.
- 4.4. Host will provide accommodation while other expenses such as flight ticket and living cost during activities will be provided by the Guest.


5. Faculty collaboration for the purpose of joint research

- 5.1. Joint research between faculty of health sciences of EUU especially nursing and nutrition study program with medical health of AU can be done immediately after the signing of the MoA.
- 5.2. Joint research can be carried out at EUU and or at AU with the funding could be discussed later among researchers. Research is a joint intellectual property rights so as to publication must include the names of all researchers from both EUU and AU.




